#### Private Grants

This year we applied for and won 2 private grants that bring in additional opportunities for our school

- The **Variety Schools Grant** provided a \$2,246 Indoor Sensory Path for our school that will be install next year (PAC paid half).
- The **Best Buy School Tech Grant** - Best Buy granted us \$3,500 to buy 18 electronic recorders for the music program, expanding the inclusion of students in future music performances. These have been purchased, but not received yet, so look for them in next year's concerts! (no cost to PAC)
